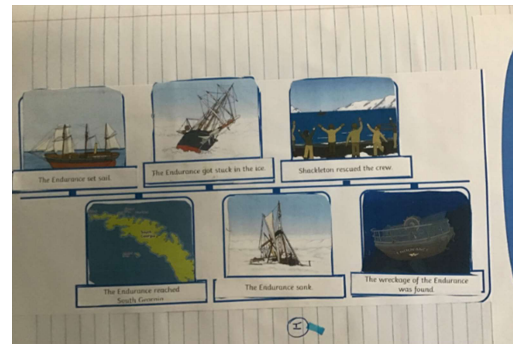
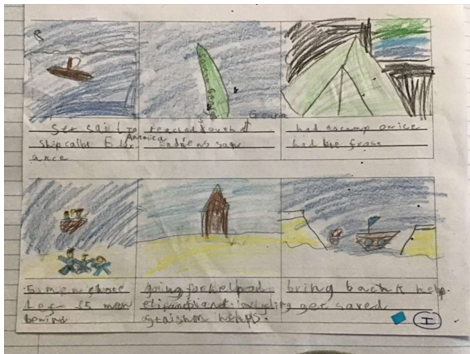




Jet Class Newsletter
