We have a local volunteer from Read with Me, who comes in once a week (and two more volunteers who are completing their training due to join soon). Since the pandemic, we have a smaller group of parent helpers to hear children read, so we are very grateful to these new volunteers for giving their time for our children. 'Our volunteers hear primary school children read twice a week for 10-15 minutes – we provide one to one time. This creates discussion which in turn improves social and communication skills and builds confidence. **This confidence is vital.** We help give those children the building blocks of self-belief'.
