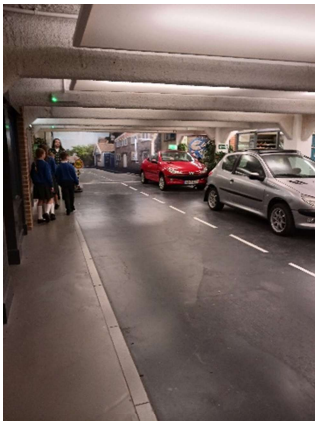


Maths – Using all four operations to solve problems. Children are showing great application of the skills we have been learning.
