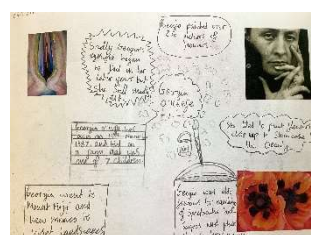
Science- The children have been exploring different classification of plants this week. A few children have shared their Science home learning already.
