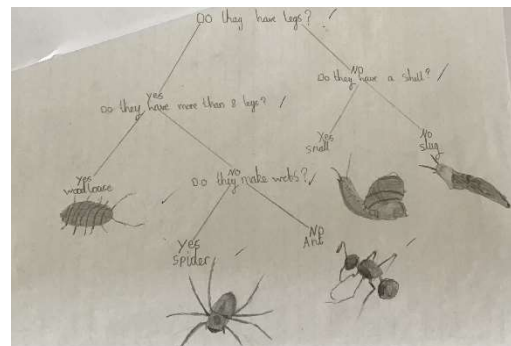
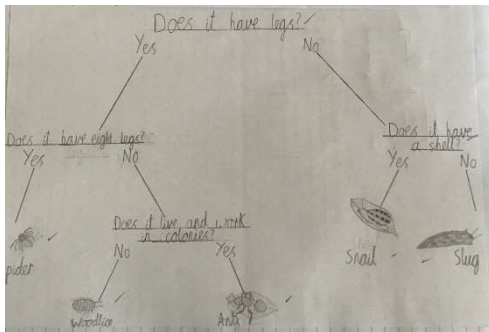


Project – The children have been choosing how to present their non-chronological report on Fair Trade and I have been impressed with the quality of their learning in their journals.
