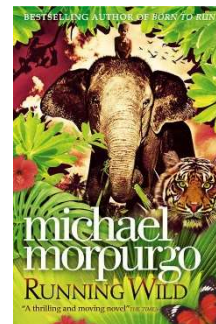
Diamond Class Newsletter
