




This week in maths we have been rounding numbers to the nearest 10,100 and 1000 including solving many complex problems. We have also been adding and subtracting 10, 100 and 1000 to numbers.

In English, we have been writing news reports linked to the text 'The Phone Booth in Mr Hirota's Garden'. Alongside this, we have continued to read our class book 'Running Wild', learning a lot about life in the rainforest.
