



Jet Class Newsletter

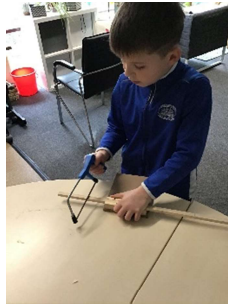
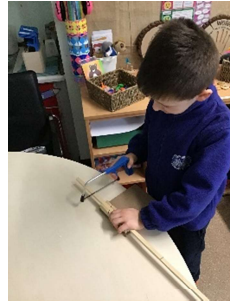
