Term 4 has got off to a busy start in Ruby class this week!

In **English** we have shared our new book 'Lost in the toy museum' by David Lucas. We have been using adjectives to describe features of the main character, Bunting. We used our ideas to help us to write sentences for a character description. In **Maths** we have started our learning about measures by comparing length and height using the vocabulary longer, taller, shorter. We have begun to look at rulers and reading simple measurements in cm. We have been enjoying exploring the toys loan box from Yate Heritage Centre to support our **History** learning about how toys have changed over time. We noticed using our Science knowledge that the materials of older toys tended to be different to newer toys.
