

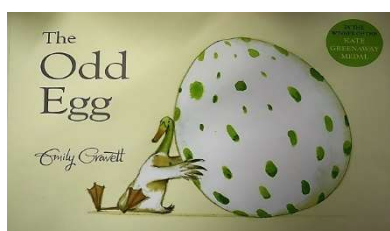


Topaz News
