

Topaz News



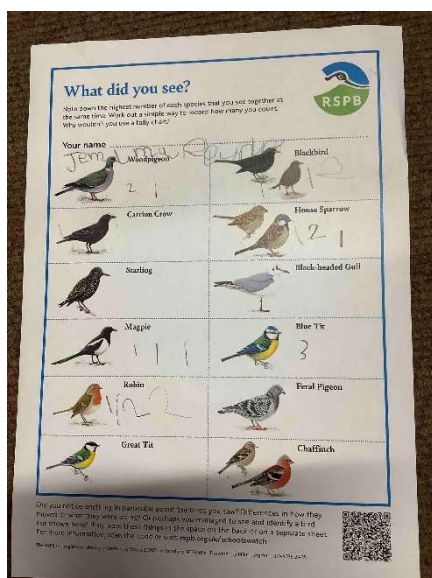
