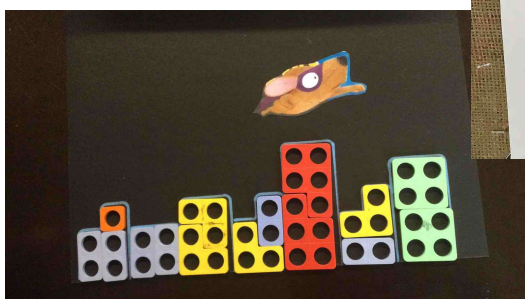


Topaz News
